ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE (ACC)

Standard Architectural Policy (SAP)

General Standards for Mechanical Equipment:

- All mechanical equipment enclosures, commercial and residential, require ACC approval of colors, materials and location prior to their construction.
- HVAC units, pool pump equipment, above ground propane tanks, and generators are a few examples of mechanical equipment required to be enclosed.
- Enclosures must include access gates to screen equipment from all views while allowing access for maintenance and repairs as prescribed by the manufacturer's guidelines.
- Installation must allow for the proper clearances as prescribed by the manufacturer's instructions and/or building code requirements.
- Installation is allowed in a side or rear yard. Installations are prohibited in front yards.
- Masonry, metal, and composite decking are appropriate materials for enclosures. Metal and composite slats
 must be installed on a horizontal plane. Please note, some HOA's and POA's may restrict certain materials.
 When there is a conflict in design criteria, the most restrictive requirement shall govern.
- Screens may NOT have covers that impede the proper function of the mechanical equipment.

General Standards for Trash Enclosures:

- All trash enclosures, commercial and residential, require ACC approval of colors, materials and location prior to their construction.
- Trash enclosures are not required, but are recommended, for 1 and 2 single family dwellings.
- Trash enclosures **ARE** required for multi-family and commercial projects.
- Mult-family projects must construct a communal enclosure, preferably for commercial type dumpsters, not individual trash receptacles.
- **Commercial and multi-family enclosures must have a concrete pad**. These enclosures should be located as to minimize their visual impact on the community while allowing access for installation and maintenance of the receptacle.
- Masonry, metal, and composite decking are appropriate materials for enclosures. Metal and composite slats
 must be installed on a horizontal plane. Please note, some HOA's and POA's may restrict certain materials.
 When there is a conflict in design criteria, the most restrictive requirement shall govern.

Be advised, requests for project approval may require other, existing non-compliant issues to be addressed including but not limited to:

- Adress yard lights
- Mechanical and Utility Equipment Screens and Trash Enclosures
- Landscapes not installed or maintained to minimum standards.
- Removal of non-approved exterior elements added without ACC and/or City approval.
